Job Description: Under the supervision of the Monitoring Coordinator the incumbent will assist with the following activities – conduct fieldwork for monitoring stream chemistry and flow, biological monitoring for algae and aquatic invertebrates, stream habitat characterization, equipment calibration and maintenance, data entry, record keeping, report writing, and additional tasks as assigned.

The Organization: The Central Coast Ambient Monitoring Program (CCAMP) is the central coast's regionally scaled water quality monitoring and assessment program. The CCAMP mission is to collect, assess, and disseminate water quality information to aid decision makers and the public in maintaining, restoring, and enhancing water quality and associated beneficial uses on the central coast.

Minimum Qualifications: (in addition to duties described above):

- At least two years of education in an environmental field of study, or at least one year of experience in environmental monitoring.
- Experience with data evaluation and analysis.
- Excellent time management, organizational, verbal, and written communication skills.
- Proficient with database management and Microsoft Office (Excel, Access, Word).
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Ability to walk 1/2 mile with 20 lbs. of equipment over rough terrain to remote field sites in inclement weather.
- Valid California driver's license and clean driving record. Reliable method of personal transportation.
- Ability to travel overnight (travel expenses are reimbursed).
- Flexible schedule and available at least one full Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday per week.

Preferred Qualifications

- Understanding of basic hydrology and local ecology.
- Basic knowledge of field monitoring techniques for measuring multiple water quality parameters.

Pay, Benefits and Work Environment: Non-exempt, part-time, temporary position. Up to 30 hours/week, averaging 10 to 12 hours/week. Hourly rate starting at \$17/hour, depending on experience. Staff are employees of the Bay Foundation of Morro Bay (Bay Foundation) and support CCAMP. The Bay Foundation is a non-profit corporation that provides the administrative framework for CCAMP and is an equal opportunity employer.
